

Les verbes -ir

Français 3/4/AP

Present tense of *remplir* (to fill, to fill out)

<i>je remplis</i>	<i>nous remplissons</i>
<i>tu remplis</i>	<i>vous remplissez</i>
<i>il, elle, on remplit</i>	<i>ils, elles remplissent</i>

Other verbs conjugated like *remplir* include the following:

<i>réagir</i>	to react, to resist, to respond
<i>atterrir</i>	to land
<i>avertir</i>	to warn
<i>divertir</i>	to amuse, to distract
<i>jouir</i>	to enjoy
<i>nourrir</i>	to nourish
<i>envahir</i>	to invade
<i>fournir</i>	to supply
<i>garantir</i>	to guarantee
<i>grandir</i>	to grow up, to raise (children)
<i>saisir</i>	to grasp, to seize, to capture
<i>trahir</i>	to betray
<i>pourrir</i>	to rot, to decay
<i>vomir</i>	to vomit
<i>bondir</i>	to leap

<i>affablir</i>	to weaken, to undermine
<i>définir</i>	to define
<i>éclaircir</i>	to clarify, to clear up, to lighten
<i>divertir</i>	to amuse, to distract
<i>fleurir</i>	to flourish, to blossom
<i>amortir</i>	to muffle (sound), to cushion (blow), to pay off
<i>brandir</i>	to brandish, to wave
<i>s'agir de</i>	to be a question of, to deal with

Le verbe *réagir*: **réagir contre** - to resist with an action

Nous réagissons contre son autorité.

réagir à - to respond immediately *Il réagit à* ses mots cruels.

réagir sur - to react (move) in response to something *Vous réagissez sous* ses coups de pied.

Most of the time, one will use **réagir contre**

Le verbe *avertir*: *Ils avertissent* leur ami **du** danger. *Tu avertis* ton fils **de** ranger la chambre.
